**Treasurer's Report:** Martina distributed current budget information. Our total assets are \$20,063.50. Recent purchases to Drums On Sale for \$850.70. Noted there has been a large increase in cost of line paint. \$650 paid to Mr. Moran for music arrangement and \$300 is left in that part of budget for new pep band music to be played in the stands. Re: the Lotto Raffle- no money will be made by us until we sell \$1500 of tickets (covers us if there is a winner everyday) Kathy will do the follow up on the Lotto winners. Tag Day and Car Wash are coming up and a Baker Park. Sold \$590 worth of Lotto tickets at Jefferson and Burkittsville Carnivals. Re: insurance-our policy is on autopay. Motion by Laurie to accept Treasurer's Report. Dave seconds.

**Fundraiser's:** Tee Shirt Ad Sales- Laurie reported on this and suggested we sell the shirts to students at cost(\$6.00) and to families for a little more as a fundraiser (\$10.00) Motion by Laurie to sell the shirts for cost to students and\$10.00 to families. Second by Dave. Motion passes.

Sock Hop- Debbie discussed a Sock Hop on Sept. 24 at Brunswick Community Center. Tickets would be \$3 to get in or \$2 if bring canned good. More details to be worked out. Train Banks- Martina will distribute. Last year made \$900. Martina also discussed the health forms that would have to be notarized to be sure we get accurate health information about each student.

Raffle Tickets – Will be distributed later- the Porters printed up and cut up the tickets over the summer.
