General Membership Meeting  
Monday, October 10, 2006

A general membership meeting was held on Monday October 10 beginning at 7 pm in the BHS library. Minutes : Motion to accept the minutes as emailed and distributed by Denise, second by Kevin. Motion Passes

Treasurer's Report: Bob supplied recently financial and budget updates. Recent payments include: colorguard uniforms-\$271, colorguard equipment-\$104, music arrangement-\$1,000, recurring fees for special instruction \$900 and guard- \$200, marimba-\$1500. For income: band fees-\$1800-Bob will check to see if all paid for, Lotto Raffle-\$730-it is ongoing, Tee shirt sales-\$846—still waiting for invoice , Parade-\$100, Basket Bingo-net \$1,477, Train Banks-\$671, TOB-\$235 income from ads and have spent \$862 so far., burger burn-\$332.23-may receive a grant from Sam's  
Current bank balance \$26,286.77

Motion by Kevin to accept treasurer's report. Second by Bill. Motion passes.

Special Guest: Jill Wilton- She is staff volunteer coordinator and asked boosters to report their volunteer hours (if you can count that high!!) Turn in your hours before May- you can fill out a form or just email Mrs. Wilton at the school.  
She also reminds volunteers to respect confidentiality and be aware of blood borne pathogens if a student cuts themselves. Allow staff to assist and wear gloves. There is a benefit to the school if we report our volunteer hours-so please report them any time between now and May.

Unfinished business:

Golf cart-no change in status-big thanks to Webbers for back up tractor.

ACC bus- there are 2 – 55 seat buses tentatively reserved. \$3600 for both is due Nov. 3- there is a 10 day period before departure that can cancel it. Parent bus would be separate from students if enough parents reserved spaces. The charge is based on the # of parents that sign up. Money is budgeted for gas for ACC's/

Bingo- Debbie said it was a great day, but there were conflicts with other Bingo's. She will try Ruritan next time. She thanked all who helped and Debbie was thanked for her hard work.

Wreath: Dave said 2 weeks left before we need a count

Talent Show: Laurie reports that Mr. Vogtman is already planning a cabaret, so it was decided to not pursue our talent show.

TOB show: Last meeting before show will be Tues Oct. 17 at 7 pm

Jim has put schedule on Website-will have 14 competing bands, us and Shepherd.  
Publicity-Dorothy said local newspaper, adelpia, radio posters, word is getting out  
Nancy Baker suggests Brunswick gov't and Channel 99.

Ads- Laurie said she sold some to colleges.

Shepherd band-It was decided to provide a snack or drinks to Shepherd when they arrive

Signs- Kevin will paint wooden signs form the shed and put one on each exit on the highway.

Trophies- Dave said there are 19 sponsors, Andy Baum donated to upsize the plaques.

Have 13 plaques and 14 trophies—will need table

Vendor is coming to make tee shirt and hoodies and has a design made up—will need table and access to electric. Bob would like to use the design for our program—it was suggested that we put an ad for this vendor in program.

Dave says we are very close to covering our expenses for trophies. Using Accent Imaging Trophy co.

Programs- Bob needs access to a scanner-program is coming along

He knows a printer who will do these for .75 each- consider 300- 400. Suggested price was \$3.00 . Deadline for program is Friday Oct. 13.

Logistics: Kevin needs 17 tables, tent for each satellite concession, welcome center,Hemp's is donating tent. Kevin says whatever you lend, be sure it has your name on it so it can get returned. He will put an email out with items needed to be borrowed such as pop-up tents, tables, extension cords, coolers with ice , and Nancy is asking for baked goods, and taco meat and seasoning.

Debbie says cheaper to buy coke from store than have the truck here.

Denise has been working on novelties—also pins. She has all the coffee cans she needs for the voting for fav band.

They will be resodding infield, so need to mark with cones to keep bands off.

Mrs. Campagnoli says we will have 2 police officers.

Denise will send our flyers out via Valley School.

Motion by Bob to pay Matthew 6 days early. Second by Dan. Motion Passes
