General Membership Meeting  
Monday February 12, 2007

A general membership meeting of the Brunswick High School Band Boosters was held on Monday Feb. 12, 2007 starting at 7 pm. In attendance were: Mr. Groen, Howie Lore, Jim Moler, Keith Webber, Bob Cummings, Denise and Ashley Hill, Debbie and Kimmy Crutchfield, Caroline O'Connell, Sharon Edelstein, Sandy Myers and Laurie Kaler.

Secretary's Report: Motion to accept minutes by Denise/Second by Keith. Motion passes.

Treasurer's Report: Updated budget information was made available.

On the expense side: \$144.30 was paid for uniform cleaning and 1,484.68 bus fee. Income included \$500 for Veterans Parade and \$96 from Boy Scouts for wreath. Credit from Valley PTA was \$415 for a total income of \$3930 for TOB show.

Project \$3,793.00 surplus, but are pending expenses for awards, banquet, possible incentive and Community Foundation.

Discussed purchasing instruments-Debbie suggested EBay as a source and Caroline suggested talking to music instructors.

Sharon suggests talking to Mr. Beaton about matching funds to match income from basketball concession which has been earmarked for instrument fund.

Jim says may need to pay accountant for tax forms.-an additional expense.

Burger Burn- not sure if Sam's club will come thru with matching grant

Denise pointed out that after our competition we sold \$100.73 worth of concession goods to Athletic Boosters via Becky Smith-but we never got paid. Nancy left paper itemizing goods. Discussed various possible solutions.

National Judge's Assoc. --\$250 for next year.

Bears for concession stand--\$250

Bob will make copy of a bounced check and mail to the parents.

Motion to accept Treasurer's Report by Laurie/Second by Keith. Motion passes

Mr. Groen: Several instructors would like to offer private music lessons. Caros and Palfy would teach brass and trumpet and there is a lady who would teach woodwinds. Cost would be \$25/half hour. Would need to work out location for lessons.

Drumline is doing well.

Banquet night is Thursday. Andy Baum will have a video presentation

New Giant in Urbana is opening and Jazz Band will perform and get \$250

Concert band will be once a week form 6 – 8 pm

Jazz Festival—Mr. G is looking into this for the spring

Indoor Drumline: Expenses: Instruction=\$1,000 Equipment=250 KIDA=150 Vendor fee=150 Music=250 Uniforms=5 x 45 (guard can buy for them for themselves)

Drumline =Hats \$173 and kids purchased shirts Props=150 Bus fee=300 Trailer fee=100  
Income: Fees=\$1200 (16x75) Consignment=600 Dominoes fundraiser=930 (7 cards per member)

Denise is running consignment on March 31 at SW High School-she could use some help, if anyone is available.

Motion for Boosters to pay KIDA dues bond of \$120 and vendor fee of \$125 to be reimbursed –by Sharon/second by Denise. Motion Passes.

Golf cart-Keith reports that the cart lives! Motor, speed controller, and switch had problems. They didn't charge us labor. Total of \$325 Keith recommends the cart be stored inside- he has it in the trailer and in spring suggests we clean out storage buildings.

Thanks to Keith for working on the golf cart and Keith and Caroline for dry cleaning the band uniforms. And to Denise for washing guard uniforms

TOB competition: Sent application in –but not officially on the schedule yet. Website: On Track to ACC's Jim will pursue all bands that attended last year. We had sufficient parking Date is Oct. 20 at 5 pm /Raindate is Oct 21 at 2 pm. Discuss advertising a limit on number of entrants and keeping a waiting list.

Taxes due Apr. 17—State due May 15. Form 1099 for instructors due at end of January

Lights on the baseball field due to be removed in 2 ½ years. Mike Tome is head of group trying to raise \$125,000 and have \$25,000 so far for new lights. They asked us to help with a fundraiser. We will get more details.

Incentives: Kimmy reported that the band voted to go to Rock and Bowl.

Motion to spend up to \$528 dollars for Rock and Bowl for band students at the Terrace Lanes on 2/24 from 11 pm – 2 am made by Sharon/ Second by Denise.

Families can join in for \$16 each.

Pep Band –Play offs start Friday.
