General Membership Meeting
December 10, 2007

A meeting of the Brunswick High School Band Boosters was held on Monday December 10 at 7 pm at BHS in the library. In attendance were: Mr. Groen, Debbie Crutchfield, Keith Webber, Bob Cummings, Nancy Baker, Denise Hill, John Morin, Tricia Barnhouse, Chris Haugen, Darren Leu and Laurie Kaler

Secretary's Report: Motion by Denise to accept minutes as emailed and distributed. Second by Keith. Motion Passes

Treasurer's Report: Bob provided current budget statements. Recent income was \$325 collected from ACC bus riders (parents). Expenditures were ACC food, gas and truck rental and uniform cleaning before ACC's. Also final two payments for special instruction band (\$3200) and payment to special instruction guard (\$200) One invoice received for bus fees \$654.67 and misc. shoe paint 6.29. Payment made for \$1734.00 for tee shirt costs, leaving a profit of \$2612.00 for tee shirt sales. Mickman wreaths are still not finished. ACC tickets in negative as Keith is trying to collect money from a couple of individuals. Disney deposits are \$1643.00 Wolfgang candy balance is \$1249.14 Popcorn is \$396.00 at this point.

Proposed Indoor Color Guard Budget. There are 9 members. Instruction is \$1500 Uniform is \$475. Proposed income is member fees, program ads, consignments, KIDA show, Upbeat Music novelties, Friend of the Guard, Yankee Candle Fundraiser, T-shirt sales, Donations, It was discussed that middle school participants are not required to pay dues, but can make a donation if they want to. Equipment is \$145/girl x8

Need to reduce income side by \$145 will take out of show. Estimate of show will be \$1370 and total guard budget \$5,335.00

Motion by Keith to accept Indoor Guard Budget. Second by Denise. Motion Passes.

Motion by Denise to accept Treasurer's Report. Second by Mr. Groen. Motion Passes.

Mr. Groen: Christmas Concert –8th graders will do a short performance. Laurie will put announcement in Brunswick Citizen about it.

Re: Disney Trip-- 2 hotels are possible- Holiday Inn (\$375) about 1 mile from Disney or Ramada Inn (\$349) includes buffet breakfast

Debbie discussed visiting Medieval Times in Florida or a water park or cash reimbursement if costs less than originally anticipated

Boosters are funding a workshop at Disney where students sightread music from a Disney movie, work with techs, and then are recorded. Cost is \$900.

Band Banquet is Feb. 13 at 6:30pm –but there is a basketball game-Feb 12 is new reschedule date. Feb 21 is snow date.

Bowling on Jan 20 fell on Shepherd Honor band so will be rescheduled to Jan 22-there is no school the next day-Terrace Lanes will be location of bowling outing (incentive event)

New Business: Denise discussed Indoor Guard Show will be held on Feb 9 –sharing date with Judy Chang and her Chinese New Year Event. Denise needs to pay KIDA their

annual fees. Volunteer forms are being sent out-Need announcer-Billy Ferrell is not available. Kevin McCarthy was suggested as a possible announcer. Elna will do trophies.

Bob recommends a special meeting to iron out show details after Christmas/New Year's. Mike Smith will help with parking. Howie will take care of judges. Meeting will be Jan 3 in library at 7 pm Denise is doing food and novelties. Brenda is looking for flowers. Ads are coming through Denise. Bob is doing program.

Basketball concessions profit had been designated to go to guard for capitol improvement-this year will be a mat.

Mr. G is looking at a brass and fiberglass tuba. Laurie suggested we go ahead with the tenor, bari and sousaphone purchases that have been approved by the Boosters so the kids can start using them.
