General Membership Meeting
January 14, 2008

A meeting of the Brunswick High School Band Boosters was held on January 14, 2008 at the BHS library at 7 pm. Secretary's Report: Motion by Denise to approve the minutes as emailed and provided. Second by Dorothy. Motion Passes.

Treasurer's Report: Bob provided budget report. Total income from TOB show was \$3,513.00 16 hours for custodians.

Bank Balance is \$28,556.00

Expenses were distribution of 3 checks to recent BHS graduates who helped with marching band. (\$450)

Additional income: \$210 for tee shirts, \$25 for donation, \$576 from Silent Auction, Wreaths were \$408.79

Disney info—almost all deposit are refundable less \$100—they will credit \$100 towards any trip in the future. Debbie says this company has been very good to work with

Income from basketball concessions is \$908.11 before expenses

Colorguard expenses: \$325 towards instruction, flags, poles, tarp—will be considered capitol expense, shoes \$176, gloves \$65, --flag bags—girls will have personalized and use as a sports bag. Fees received \$325, Friend of the guard \$150, Tshirt ad \$140

General Marching Budget is still open as not sure have received bills for all the buses.

Cost of tarp for indoor guard is \$1327.00 and cart for it is \$400

Motion by Bob to pay for the tarp and cart for indoor guard from Boosters as capitol expense investment, and put basketball concessions as a line item to assist in Indoor Color Guard's expenses. Second by Bill. Motion Passes.

Motion by Denise to approve Treasurer's Report. Second by John. Motion Passes.

Old Business: Instrument estimates form Duet with Music: Bari Sax \$2100, Tenor 1500, Trombone 600, Sousaphone 2500. We currently have both sets of legs for xylophones—the all terrain are \$200 extra—need to decide which one to keep.

Mr. G discussed fiberglass tuba from Music and Arts for a similar amount as Duet's price. Laurie says that Eric from Duet with Music has supported the band for many years.

Jessica Howard's mom, Phyllis, had made a \$300 donation to band from the trust fund towards Florida trip. Now that the trip is cancelled, Debbie will call and see what Phyllis would like the band to do with the donation.

Money raised by students toward the cancelled trip will be given to the students or paid toward any outstanding balance they have with band.

Banquet: Decorations ordered, Denise and Debbie will use left over food from Indoor Guard show on Sat. Banquet is Tues Feb 12 at 6:30—no school primary election day.

Bowling will be 1/22 –lanes reserved and Keith or Bob will pay \$25 deposit Time is 9:30- midnight.

Banquet- Nancy says 200 pieces of chicken, two –half sheet cakes. Little pins are preferred to put on jackets. Nancy will invite 8th grade. Robin found a source for getting band pins- it was discussed to order in bulk.

Mrs. Campagnoli mentioned that Feb 11 was incoming 9th grade registration night and the building might be busy - including library- may affect booster meeting.

Nancy asked Mrs. C if there would be more dates available for possible band trip. Would the Martin Luther King break be an acceptable time. Mrs. C said main concern is when there is testing, HAS's, and unpredictable winter weather that throws schedules off.

John Morin discussed having a large band picture framed and put up in band room. He has a good source that does an excellent job at this.

Motion by Laurie to have picture framed and start a tradition of band pix each year displayed in band room. Second by Denise. Motion carries

Indoor Show- Denise says 13 units are expected and can take a max. of 16. Registration packets and maps are completed for directors. Check and information has been sent to KIDA. Logistics are finished. Denise will email to anyone interested. Need volunteers to help—especially adults. Need monitors, runners, ticket sales, souvenir sales, escorts.

Advertising-Keith and Jim will help get the word out. Chris H and Darren L can tell 8th graders about Indoor Guard show and the banquet. Several band members will be performing for about one half hour for the Chinese New Year celebration which will be going on simultaneously with the indoor show. Elna is handling trophies and will be looking for sponsors. Programs-Bob is handling. Debbie will email welcome letter for program. Katie Tregoe is only senior and it was discussed about doing write ups on the guard members. John will take pictures on 1/26 and there will be a group guard picture in program. 1/26 will also be a preview show in Old Gym. Floor crew can practice. One
