Speakers and amplifiers are needed and there was a discussion on the need to purchase and/or ask for donations for guitar amplifiers and speakers. Mr. Glidewell said that there would be additional charges for the Copyrights to the Marching Band show music and that in the future copyrights should be considered in with the cost of the band music.
