Meeting Called to order at 7:05 by Band Booster President, Jim Moler.

Minutes from September meeting were reviewed; no changes were made.

*****MOTION*****

Denise Hill made a motion to approve September minutes, seconded by Robin Webber. Motion carried by a voice vote.

Treasurer's Report: Bob Cummings reported on financial activity as highlighted in the October 2008 Budget Report (attachment #1). On the September 2008 Budget Report, \$191.46 was listed as a Band/Percussion Equipment expense. This amount has been recategorized under Miscellaneous expense. On the October 2008 Budget Report, there were new Band/Percussion Equipment expenses totaling \$486.10. The total Miscellaneous expense (\$648.46) includes the recategorized expense and will be fully detailed on next month's report. TOB insurance fee decreased due to class of business, \$300.00 increase in Color Guard Budget for equipment (swing flags) was approved by Executive Board via e-mail. Unable to obtain copyright permission for one arrangement despite repeated attempts. An outstanding invoice for \$417.50 was paid to Upper Perk Sportswear for staff t-shirts from last year's TOB show. The final report for the 2007 TOB show has been updated to show a profit of \$3,095.50 (attachment #2).

*****MOTION*****

Keith Webber made a motion to accept the October Treasurer's Report, seconded by Nancy Baker. Motion carried by a voice vote.

Executive Board Report: Keith Webber reported on Executive Board activity since September's meeting. A \$300.00 adjustment/increase in the Color Guard Budget was approved via e-mail; balance due for band fees will be mailed directly to homes in care of parent/guardian. The City of Brunswick has offered the Band Boosters a donation in return for student manpower to plant shrubs/flowers around the newly refurbished Veteran's Memorial in Brunswick. The Board approved this fundraising opportunity. Charlie Smith is the contact person and we will need to touch base with him in the early spring. Keith thanked the boosters and families on behalf of the students for providing lunch/food for the double-header competitions; Jim, Sara, Mr. Glidewell and Keith met to discuss indoor Color Guard Budget. He also reported that the Board decided to go with Schrock's Bus Company for the ACC's. Schrock's did not require a deposit in advance (as did Kewl and Virginia Coach); \$2,100 payment due by October 31st.

Coolers of food for kids will be organized for their meals; they will not be stopping to eat on the way home because of the hour.

TOB Committee Report: Jim Moler reported on the changes in times on the performance schedule (attachment #3). The start time of the TOB show was pushed back an hour to 12:00 pm. This will allow any band student who is taking the ACT exam on October 25th a chance to return for the exhibition performance. We will be modifying our publicity where possible to reflect the new start time. Skip Wizards will be performing at intermission; they need to use school's sound system. There was a discussion on giving them a \$50.00 gas card for performing at our show.

*****MOTION*****

Elna Morin made a motion to give Skip Wizards a \$50.00 gas card, seconded by Darlene Doss. Motion carried by a voice vote.

Mike Tome with Brunswick Junior Baseball asked if they could sell raffle tickets for an ATV at our show. This raffle would be for the "Save the Lights" campaign to install new lighting at the Baseball Field. The Band uses these lights when practicing in the evenings. It was decided that it would be OK if the raffle were only for the ATV and not for money.

*****MOTION*****

Laurie Kaler made a motion to allow Brunswick Junior Baseball to sell raffle tickets at our show if it's for the ATV only, seconded by Elna Morin. Motion carried by a voice vote.

Robin Webber reported that volunteers are in place for the show, seniors will be escorts, novelties and concessions are other areas that students can help in.

Trip Committee Report: Jim Moler reported that Mike Smith would not be able to continue chairing this committee. Keith will call a meeting to determine if we should continue to pursue a trip.

Uniform Committee Report: Elna Morin reported some uniforms may have paint on them and she and Robin would look them over carefully for cleanliness.

Band Director's Report: Mr. Glidewell reported that the Regional Championship to take place between Chapters and ACC's at Century or Mechanicsburg is optional. The scores will not have any effect on how we place in the ACC's. He said he would discuss it with the students to determine their level of interest. There would be some cost for a bus if they were to go. Mr. Glidewell said he is getting the run around from anyone and everyone who might have something to do with him obtaining the copyright approval on one piece. Three out of four copyrights and two out of three publishers (two copyrights have same publisher) have been approved. Pep Band will be offered this year and the Band Boosters will be running concessions during girls' home basketball games.

*****MOTION*****

Mr. Glidewell made a motion to purchase a silver lacquered full size Yamaha Tuba that is being held for BHS at Music and Arts for \$3,675.00, as soon as the Band Boosters has received a refund from Woodwind Brasswind for the 3/4 Tuba, seconded by Keith Webber. Motion carried by a voice vote.

NEW BUSINESS:

Indoor Guard Budget: The proposed indoor guard budget (attachment #4) was reviewed and discussed. The budget will be voted upon at next month's meeting.
