Meeting Called to order at 7:05 by Band Boosters President, Jim Moler

Minutes from October meeting were reviewed; no changes were made.

MOTION

Elna Morin made a motion to approve October minutes, seconded by Trina Barnhouse. Motion carried by a voice vote.

Treasurer's Report: Bob Cummings reported on financial activity as highlighted in the November 2008 Marching Band Budget Report (attachment #1). TOB bus is paid for except for tip, there are still a few empty seats still available. \$35.00 miscellaneous for Sams Club renewal, T-Shirt ads and Sales activity still going on. The 2008 TOB Summary (attachment #2) was distributed. Discussion on this report will be held at the Nov 11th TOB Competition Follow-up meeting.

MOTION

John Morin made a motion to accept Treasurer's Report, seconded by Denise Hill. Motion carried by a voice vote.

Director's Report: Mr. Glidewell began his report by thanking everyone for an excellent job on our TOB show; he received positive feedback from director's and judges. The Tuba transactions are complete, and he now has the newly purchased full size Tuba. The ACC's itinerary will go out on Tuesday November 11th. A half-day field trip has been approved for Band students on the Monday following ACC's. Pep Band Club will be performing during the boys and girls home games, Band Boosters will run concessions at all girls' home games. Practice for Pep Band will be during club time only, Pep Band Club members only will be allowed to participate in the Pep Band during games. Equipment will be loaded on trailer at noon on Saturday, coolers & miscellaneous items will be loaded on Sunday morning. We will pay an extra \$60.00 rental fee for the truck and will plan on un-loading it on Monday afternoon. Canopy will be taken. Need emergency cards for four students doing props. Keith Webber is still waiting to hear back from parents of seniors regarding available bus seats at \$20.00 each.

Proposed 2009 Indoor Guard Budget Report: Jim Moler reported on the Proposed Indoor Guard Budget. Mr. Glidewell will check into copyright requirements for Guard Music, he's not sure if it applies here since the music will not be re-arranged as in band, Denise will check will

Howie. Leadership for Indoor Guard fundraisers is in place. Jim Moler explained that if the Color Guard does not meet its budget that the Band Boosters will be required to do so for them. John Morin suggested having guard parents approve budget and that we should wait until after the Nov 25th Color Guard meeting to approve the budget. A general discussion on these ideas and suggestions took place.

Bob Cummings summarized the Indoor Guard budget; comments were made concerning guard parent's approving the budget, and the overall responsibilities of the Band Boosters for this program were discussed as well.

Motion to approved the 2009 Indoor Color Guard Budget carried by a voice vote.

SAVE THE LIGHTS: Mike Tome with the Brunswick Junior Baseball made a presentation concerning the lights on the baseball field and asked if the Band Boosters would be willing to assist in the fundraising effort to replace the lights. They have done a letter campaign, raffles, and a memorial brick patio and suggested that the Band Boosters, PTSA, and Athletic Boosters collaborate in hosting a Basket Bingo to help raise money. August 2010 is the deadline for continued use of the light poles.

At 8:45, Mr. Glidewell made a motion to adjourn the Band Booster meeting, seconded by Denise Hill. Motion carried by a voice vote.
