**Meeting Called to order** at 7:00 pm by Band Boosters President, Jim Moler

**Minutes** from December meeting were reviewed; no changes were made.

Denise Hill made a motion to approve the December minutes, seconded by Steve Lowery.  
Motion carried by a voice vote.

**Nominating Committee:** Robin Webber reported for the Nominating Committee, (attachment #4). Steve Lowery is undecided on his nomination as Band Booster President, Sharon Edelstein will accept nomination for Vice President if Steve Lowery accepts nomination for president. Steve will let Band Boosters know his final decision as soon as possible. A brief discussion was held on the by-laws and requirements to fill the president position in the case of a blank slate for presidency. Elections need to be held at the February meeting; new officers take office at the March general meeting. Mr. Glidewell discussed the number of seniors leaving at the end of this school year, and the possible number of new students who will participate in marching band next year. Jim Moler will consult Roberts Rules to see what the boosters should do if there are no candidates for president and vice president. Dorothy Moler will send out e-mails updating the nomination results.

**Treasurer's Report:** Bob Cummings reported on the financial activity for the 2008 Approved Marching Band Budget January Report (attachment #1), Approved 2009 Indoor Color Guard Budget – January 2009 Report (attachment #2), and the January 12<sup>th</sup> 2009 Supplemental Budget Report (attachment #3). All new expense and income activity is highlighted in yellow. Steve Lowery reported that McDonald's will be sending the Band Boosters a total of \$700.00 for several family night fundraisers. He has already received one check for \$200.00. Steve will give all McDonald's money to Bob once he has received the total amount due. Jim Moler reported that the Band Boosters is still receiving an invoice for the new Tuba; Bob Cummings said the check was mailed out on November 29; Jim will look into this. Correction to the treasurer's report: \$14.00 for ACC Ticket Income should be listed under the Competition Ticket Sales line item for Income.

Keith Webber made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report, seconded by John Morin. Motion carried by a voice vote.

**Trip Committee:** It was decided that the cost for Carnegie Hall field trip was prohibitive as well as the payment schedule for overnight trips; buses need to be paid for and reserved. Steve Lowery reported that he is still looking into Cedar Point, Hershey Park, and Adventure Park. Jaemi Sisco and Brenda Leach agreed to help Steve and Mr. Glidewell on the Trip Committee.

**Uniform Committee:** Elna Morin reported that the football uniforms have been cleaned, shoes have been returned to students, bags have been emptied of all personal items and are ready for next season. She will have the competition uniforms cleaned after the All County Band concert and garment bags cleaned as needed. Elna and Keith Webber discussed the locations of garment racks and their destinations. Many thanks to Keith and Robin Webber for donating two garment racks to the band!

**Director's Report:** Mr. Glidewell reported that the Shepherd Honor Band was a huge success and an enriching experience for the 12 students who participated. BHS has 7 students participating in the All County Band which is a considerably higher number of students than in years past. He hopes next year to have students participate in the All State Band.

Mr. Glidewell made a motion to give John Karos \$225.00 left over from Special Instruction monies for helping with the Pep Band. Motion carried by a voice vote.

**Unfinished Business:**

**Indoor Guard Fundraisers:**

Fundraisers are going well and are on schedule. Uncle Ralph's cookie dough orders are due by January 27<sup>th</sup> and will be delivered the week before Valentine's Day. Yankee Candle fundraiser will take place in February. Indoor Guard had a business Tag Day to sell ads for the KIDA program. They had good attendance – all but 3 members participated. There are a total of 13 guard members.

**KIDA Show:** Denise Hill reported on the progress for the 2009 KIDA Show and discussed logistics (attachment #5). A use of facility form still needs to be filed with Perry Baker. Lisa Hadley is in charge of all concessions. Donuts and beverages will be served until 10:00 a.m.; cafeteria will open at 10:00 a.m. for hot food. Awards scheduled for 2:10, facility has to be cleaned and restored by 4:00 p.m. for basketball game. Denise or Keith will contact automotive department about moving vehicles out of the loading dock areas. There is no publicity/advertising person yet. Elna Morin will coordinate with Mr. Player at BMS in handing out VIP passes to 8<sup>th</sup> grade band students. There will be a KIDA Show meeting on Friday, February 13<sup>th</sup>.

**Schrock Tour and Charter:** Jim filed a formal complaint to Schrock Tour and Charter regarding the bus driver who may have fallen asleep at the wheel on the trip back from ACC's.

The letter was sent certified mail. We received the return receipt but have not heard back from Schrock's.

**Percussion Instructor** may take legal action against Band Boosters for stopping payment on final payment for services. Jim sent a certified letter to the instructor detailing her absences and explaining the boosters decision to terminate her contract and withhold the final payment. We have not yet received a return receipt.
