Denise Hill and Keith Webber made a motion to accept the minutes as written

Reports:

Treasury: Martin stated there were several question regarding the budget.

A. The Marching Band Budget

1. There was 162.44 in the Marching Band expenses (under current activity) This item was for the Indoor Guard for buttons and ink. Since the indoor guard makes the profit from these items then they should carry the expense.

2. The Save the Light (\$3000.00) and the St. Philomena Church- Memorial Fund (\$100.00) should be listed under Capital expenses not in the Marching Band yearly budget.

3. The 268.00 under Marching Band Income (under current activity) should be listed under Prop expense.

B. The Indoor Guard Budget

1. Under Uniforms we seem to have spent a bit more then we budgeted for, there is a question as to if the company we order the uniform from didn't credit the \$700 deposit Sara will check with company.

C. KIDA show

1. Make-up listed as an expense (\$22.24) should be move to the Indoor Guard Budget.

2. Under income Elna's record show only \$685 for Trophies and we have listed \$850.00?

1.Mr. Glidewell wanted to make sure that if the students had signed up to perform for Cinderella, they needed to be there on time and ready to play.

He handed out a list of practice dates and Sharon will make sure they make it on the band calendar.

2. Mr. Glidewell informed us on the TOB show, and the fact that we have been granted the approval by both TOB and the school to host this year Chapters which will be held on Oct 24th.

a. Some items regarding this show

We can charge more because we have to pay more for the judges. We don't have to send out invitations to this show because if they want to go to ACC they need to be in the Chapters. We should have 10-15 bands. Need to see if we can get some of the out going seniors to help out as our band will not be able to help as they had for previous TOB shows. Need to see if we can get a college to play possibly Sheppard, Towson, University or Maryland.

3. Mr. Glidewell would like to get the eighth graders to one or two TOB events and let them see the band in action.

4. Also invite the eighth graders to be in the parades

5. ACC will be on two weekends Nov 1 or Nov 8 (both Sundays) at Hershey Park

Indoor Guard:

1. The guard came in first place at their last show. They have one more show before Championship.

2. The guard has been granted permission to sell T-shirts for the championships, they have also been granted permission to sell button at the championships. Each parent with a child in the guard will need to work either the t-shirt booth or the button booth for at least two hours.

Denise Hill and Mr. Glidewell made a motion to take the money from the T-shirts sale and button sale and use it to buy each member of the guard a rifle and saber' (cost about \$100.00 each)

New Business:

2009 Marching Band Budget- Question were raised regarding the ability to raise the amount of money that was needed for the budget. The board stated that by running the fundraiser starting earlier in the year and following up to make sure the fundraiser gets done each month, we should have no problem raising the funds for this budget. An example of this is doing McDonalds every month, and only making \$300, we can raise \$3600.

Also doing car washes both in Frederick at Wal-Mart/ Sams as well as doing them in Brunswick.

We are also going to get in touch with Brunswick alumni from 1975 on to see if they can either send in a small personal donation or see if we can get any corporate donations. In the letter to alumni ask them to show up for Chapters.
