Band Director's Report:

First Day of Mini-Band camp went well, three of the instructors came to the camp. They covered marching, playing, and did some warm up.

John will be writing the drills.

Need to make sure they set up Tuesday and Thursday for the Indoor Guard. Curtis made a Handbook for the band members and is planning on handing this out to the band students on Thursday.

In the handbook he made the Committees into Larger groups, and added a few, he would like to see if we could get someone to write grants, and to also have a list of people to chaperon on every trip so there is no last minute mix-ups.

In the handbook there is a contract for every band member to sign.

The band booster would like to attach a Welcome Letter and a FAQ about the band boosters.

Steve will find the welcome letter and updated as needed and get to Curtis by Wednesday.

Curtis will hand out the physical cards on Thursday with the Handbooks they need to be returned by band camp.

There will also be a 25\$ charge for the percussion line, this is to ensure they have replacement parts as needed.

Need to go to Tri-State and purchase White Electrical tape for the guns.

Computers will be ordered by July 1

Smart Music will be ordered before the end of the school year, this runs for 13 months.

Instrument Inventory:

Has not been able to complete inventory until the band room is cleaned out.

One thing that was discussed was the need to have another Marching Baritone. Curtis was looking into seeing if he could get one from another school.

A Motion was made by John and Elna that the band boosters would purchased a Marching Baritone if one could not be found from another school. The cost of the Baritone would not exceed \$2000.00. The money would come out of Capital Expense and we would shop around for the best price but would buy locally if there were only a small difference.
